**Thalassemia Awareness Walk:** DUET students collaborated with Help International Welfare Trust to support thalassemia awareness through a public walk. Student societies, including the American Society of Mechanical Engineers (ASM), IEEE DUET Chapter, Women in Engineering (WIE), Society of Civil Engineers (SCE), and the American Institute of Chemical Engineers (AIChE), played a vital role in organizing and participating in the event. This initiative brought DUET students and faculty members together to advocate for the cause, educating the public on thalassemia prevention and support for affected individuals.
