



## NOTIFICATION

In continuation to notification No. DUET/Reg/Research Hon.Policy/2021- dated 16-03-2021, it is notified for the information of all concerned that the Vice Chancellor has been pleased to revised remuneration policy for the publication of research articles, book chapters, and books by the faculty members of Dawood University based on the Journal Prestige Index (JPI).

Moreover, Higher Education Commission (HEC) has launched Journal Recognition System (HJRS), which shall be applicable for appointments and promotions. HJRS uses a novel JPI measure which is calculated as a function of a journal's internationally benchmarked and recognized prestige parameters. The relative thresholds, decided by the respective scientific review panel of HEC, on JPI are used to classify Journals into W, X or Y categories. The lowest JPI is one (1) and the highest is hundred (100).

**Policy applicability:** The policy shall be applied from July 01, 2023.

**Scope:** This policy applies to DUET Faculty members only. A publication can only be considered for reward when DUET researchers mention the affiliation of DUET in the published work. The publications include Research Articles published in journals having JPI (Issued by HEC-based HJRS), Book Chapters, and Books. The following requirements shall be considered for the remuneration.

- 1) The research paper published by a faculty member during their MS/PhD study should not be considered for the remuneration.
- 2) The research paper published under any external/internal research funding should not be considered for remuneration.
- 3) The research paper which has SCOPUS/EI/Web of Sciences indexing is applicable for the remuneration.
- 4) The research paper applied for the remuneration should have citations  $\geq 3$ . The self citations and inter-institutional should not be considered.
- 5) The existing research honorarium policy stand repealed.

### **A. RESEARCH ARTICLES**

1. The maximum reward for any JPI publication is as under:

JPI	Amount (PKR)
80-100	Rs. 70,000/-
60-79	Rs. 50,000/-
30-59	Rs. 35,000/-
01-29	Rs. 25,000/-

- a) If the corresponding author is from Dawood University of Engineering and Technology, the amount will only be sanctioned to the corresponding author. The corresponding may or may not distribute the sanctioned among the co-authors of DUET.
  - b) If there are two corresponding authors in the publication one from DUET and one from any other university then 50% of the total amount shall be sanctioned to the corresponding with DUET affiliation.
  - c) If there are more two corresponding authors in the publication and both are with DUET affiliation, then the amount will only be sanctioned to one corresponding author whose name will appear first in the author list of the research paper.
  - d) If there are more two corresponding authors, then clause 2 may be applied.
2. If there are more than two corresponding authors (3 or more) OR no co-corresponding author is with the affiliation of DUET, then the amount will be sanctioned as per the following formula.

Author role	% of Amount (PKR)
1 <sup>st</sup>	50%
2 <sup>nd</sup>	30%
3 <sup>rd</sup>	20%

**Note:** The honorarium application shall include:

- I. The JPI of the journal issued by HJRS during the paper publication date (Print the screen page).
- II. The first page of the published paper (which shows the author's role and affiliation).
- III. The evidence of citation and indexing.

#### **B. BOOKS**

Books authored by or edited by or edited by DUET faculty shall be considered for the publication honorarium. Only those books shall be considered, which do have an authentic International Standard Book Number (ISBN).

Author / Editor role	Amount (PKR)
1 <sup>st</sup>	75,000/-
2 <sup>nd</sup>	50,000/-
3 <sup>rd</sup>	20,000/-

1. If 1<sup>st</sup> author/editor is with the affiliation of DUET, a total amount of Rs. 75,000/- will only be sanctioned to the 1<sup>st</sup> author/editor. No other editors/authors shall receive a claim for the same. The first author/editor may or may not distribute any sub amounts to coauthors/coeditors of the Books.
2. If 1<sup>st</sup> author/editor is not from the DUET, then 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> author/editors with the affiliation of DUET shall receive the 50,000/- and 20,000/-, respectively.
3. If only 3<sup>rd</sup> author/editor is with the affiliation of DUET, then only Rs. 20,000/- shall be sanctioned to the author/editor.



Note: Honorarium application shall include the first few pages of the book that includes the title of the books with author/editor names and publisher, ISBN, preface, and table of content.

**C. BOOKS CHAPTERS**

1. Only those book chapters shall be considered for honorarium, which has an authentic Digital Object Identifier (DOI) number.
2. The author is from DUET; a maximum amount of Rs. 20,000/- will only be sanctioned to the first author. No other author shall receive any further reward on the same publication.
3. The 2<sup>nd</sup> author is with the affiliation of DUET. Then the author shall receive Rs. 10,000/- only.

Author role	Amount (PKR)
1 <sup>st</sup>	20,000/-
2 <sup>nd</sup>	10,000/-

Note: Along with the publication honorarium, the applicant shall attach the first page of the chapter, which shows details of authors including affiliation and DOI Number.

**Operation:**

- ORIC-DUET will receive applications (in the given format) through the dean of the concerned Faculty.
- ORIC-DUET will recommend the applications to the Vice Chancellor for rewards.

**With Effect:**

- The policy shall be effective from July 01, 2023.
- The date of "Online Available" is not available on the paper then the exact publication date/year shall be considered for the honorarium.
